

Scripture Explanation:

Heb 11:5

5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Doesn't this verse prove that Enoch is in heaven? What happened to him anyway?

John 14:14

"If you ask anything in my name, I will do it"

Can we really expect God to do anything for us as the Bible says?

2 Cor. 12:2-4

"2 I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven. 3 And I knew such a man, (whether in the body, or out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) 4 How that he was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter."

What does this verse mean vis a vi, going to heaven, paradise, and "unspeakable words" ...?

2 Kings 13:15-19

What can we learn from Joash and the "ground striking episode"?

Why would God (and Elisha) be upset at Joash from only striking the ground 3 times instead of "5 or 6"? Is there more to the story here?

Isaiah 14:9-10

"Hell from beneath is excited about you, to meet you at your coming; It stirs up the dead for you..."

Doesn't this verse contradict the idea that the dead are "sleeping" in the grave?

2 Corinthians 5:2-4

"Meanwhile we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, because when we are clothed, we will not be found naked...clothed with our heavenly dwelling"

Doesn't this verse say we will be conscious with Christ in heaven when we die?

1 Tim. 2:11-12

"A woman should learn in quietness and full submission. I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent."

What does this mean? Does this mean that women must be silent in church? What about women as leaders in the church? Doesn't 1 Cor. 11:5 imply that women were teaching in church, just with their heads covered?
